### beers on tap:

- **happy valley hefeweizen** - an american, unfiltered wheat beer that has a refreshing lightness.
- **pub pils** - a filtered czech pilsner lager that is dry, malty and bitter. this is a very aggressive beer for one so light in color.
- **upa• utah pale ale** - a very light amber colored, unfiltered ale, balanced bitterness and an extreme amount of hop flavor and aroma.
- **latter day stout** - a classic Irish stout. made with roasted barley, chocolate malts and nugget hops. it is served on the nitrogen tap to produce a rich, creamy head.

### seasonal beers:

here is our list of beers we offer throughout the year. we rotate them often so come in and try something different!

- **munich lager** - a lightly hopped, light amber colored lager.
- **summertime kristalweizen** - a light, crisp, filtered wheat beer. bitterness is low with mellow hop aroma.
- **backcountry cream ale** - a light, unfiltered ale/lager hybrid, low in bitterness and hop aroma, subtle caramel flavor.

- courtney marie's kolsch** - a light summer ale that is mild in bitterness, with medium hop aroma. very crisp for an ale.
- all the way alt** - an unfiltered german ale, dry, medium bodied, good bitterness, with little to no hop aroma or flavor. brew master's favorite.
- centennial steamer** - a california common beer. amber in color with a medium hop flavor, and strong caramel malt character.
- road rage rye** - a light colored unfiltered ale. dry flavor with medium to high hop character and maltiness. rye provides a spicy almost peppery character.
- red butte bitter** - a medium bodied red ale with a nice bitter finish. mild hop flavor.
- edge's special bitter** - a medium bodied english red ale with medium bitterness and aggressively hopped.
- anniversary amber ale** - amber colored, unfiltered pale ale. a very malty beer with a low hop flavor.
- augustus amber ale** - a reddish, amber color. clean, almost spicy, medium bitterness with high hop flavor.
- macgrueger's scottish ale** - a deep red to light brown colored, filtered, and lightly hopped malty ale. medium bodied. light hints of smoke flavor.
- downtown nut brown** - a sweet ale, light brown in color with a nutty flavor, which comes not from nuts, but from the roasted barley. medium bitterness and nice hop character.
- festival british mild** - a mild flavored brown beer brewed for the utah micro brewers festival. rich malty tones and hints of chocolate and caramel.

•**black sky porter** - a dark, roasted or coffee flavored, unfiltered ale with medium bitterness and hop character.

•**downhill dunkelweizen** – a dark, german filtered wheat ale, with strong and unique yeast flavors of vanilla and clove. little to no hop flavor or aroma with low bitterness.

•**shot in the dark coffee stout** - this is a sweet full-bodied stout with a coffee aroma and flavor. it is brewed as a normal sweet stout, then over 20 gallons of a special blend of coffee from millcreek coffee roasters is added. it is a great dessert beer.

•**holiday raspberry stout** - this is a sweet stout with a very strong flavor of chocolate malt and an underlying raspberry flavor and aroma. instead of raspberry syrup real raspberries are used when brewing this beer.

•**radius** - 100% local beer with all ingredients coming from within a 150-mile radius from salt lake city. this is a “harvest” or “green hopped” golden ale and is extremely hoppy.

•**desert helle** - a light filtered lager. medium hop character with strong barley malt flavors.

•**stupid blonde ale** - a light unfiltered blonde ale. it has low hop character and flavors of barley and wheat.

•**inversion ale** - this malty brown ale is modeled after a winter warmer without the excess alcohol. the smoky flavor comes from house-smoked malt. there is also a slight spiciness from the chocolate rye malt.

•**schwartz ein lager** - a crisp dark lager beer, with flavors of roasted malt without the associated bitterness.
